

# BATEMAN 4-H SCHOLARSHIP (COUNTY)

Scholarship Value: \$500.00

Background: This scholarship honors John and Ruth Bateman and their lives and commitment to learning and particularly the 4-H program. It is funded by the Bateman family. It provides \$500.00 for one Benton high school senior who will attend a four year college.

Purpose of Scholarship:

- To provide incentive for further education to a Benton County 4-H member who will attend a four year college
- To encourage the development of skills that will contribute to a more efficient, productive and profitable life.
- To provide for recognition of meritorious work and achievement in 4-H and furthering the college education of worthy present 4-H members.

Regulations:

Eligibility

- 4-H members enrolled during current year in a Benton County 4-H project and currently a senior in high school.
- Must have completed a minimum of three years in 4-H membership including the current 4-H year.
- There is no academic or financial need requirement.

Application Requirements:

- Benton County 4-H Bateman Scholarship form
- Oregon 4-H Permanent Record
- 4-H Essay (at least one page or no more than two pages on how the 4-H member intends to pursue "learning over an entire lifetime.")
- Two recommendations (4-H leaders, teachers, minister, coach, neighbor or other adult – not a parent)
- Project records for past two years (05-06 & 06-07) and current year (07-08).
- Project and activity pictures (optional, but important; 1 page of leadership & speaking, 1 page of community service and 1 page of project activities)

County Selection: It is the responsibility of the County Extension staff to arrange for determining county scholarship recipients.

One nominee and an alternate will be selected for the scholarship. If the winner does not enroll by the December session, the award will be given to the alternate.

**Special notes:** Class ranking and GPA will not be major criteria for selection. The scholarship winner must agree to enroll in a four year college.
