Number of Scholarships: Up to five (5)

Scholarship Value: \$750.00 (plus \$250.00 a year for the next 3 years of higher education)

Background: This is a scholarship based on ability and interests, funded by the Steven B. Moos Scholarship Fund. It provides \$750.00 (plus \$250.00 a year for the next 3 years of higher education) to up to five Benton County high school seniors interested in pursuing higher education.

### Purpose of Scholarship:

- To provide incentive for further education to Benton County 4-H animal science members who are interested in pursuing higher education.
- To encourage the development of leadership skills, build character and citizenship responsibilities.
- To apply 4-H training and experience in choosing a career.
- To encourage the development of skills that will contribute to a more efficient, productive and profitable life.
- To provide for recognition of meritorious work and achievement in 4-H and furthering the college education of worthy present 4-H members.

### Regulations:

#### Eligibility

- 4-H Members enrolled during current year in a Benton County Animal Science (beef, sheep, swine, or dairy cattle) activity and currently a senior in high school.
- Must have completed a minimum of three years in 4-H membership including the current 4-H year.
- There is no academic or financial need requirement

### Application Requirements:

- Steven B. Moos Scholarship form
- Oregon 4-H Permanent Record
- 4-H Story (essay or story of at least one page or no more than two pages on why you would like to pursue higher education and how 4-H has helped you to decide on higher education, future goals, etc.)
- Two recommendations (4-H leaders, teachers, ministers, coach, neighbor, or other adult – not a parent)
- Project records for past two years (05-06 & 06-07) and current year (07-08)
- Project and activity pictures (optional, but important; 1 page of leadership & speaking, 1 page of community service and 1 page of project activities)

County Selection: It is the responsibility of the County Extension staff to arrange for determining county scholarship recipients.

Up to five nominees and an alternate will be selected for the scholarship. If one of the winners does not enroll by the December session, the award will be given to the alternate.

**Special Notes:** Class ranking and GPA will not be a major criteria for selection. The scholarship winners **must** agree to enroll and attend the school and send a written report to the sponsor upon completion of the course.
