Albany

FISH of Albany, 1880 Hill Street SE (south of Queen Ave)

Mission: Provides food, clothing, and other services to those in need. They can serve as many as 35 – 40/day for a total of 350/month. Recipients set up appointments to pick up food M to F starting at 3 pm.

Donations: Before 3 pm M to F

Signs of Victory Open Meal Site, 120 7th Avenue SE (off Lyons)

Mission: Ministry to those trying to turn their lives around and establish stable housing and work. Church attendance is required for those who are residents. They also provide food boxes and cooked meals to anyone in need with no restrictions or requirements. They house about 40 people in two adjacent houses and feed 50 – 70/day

Donations: Donations are accepted any week day until 10 pm. However, it is best to check in with Chuck Davis (the manager) when you drop off your donation.

Salvation Army, 345 Columbus St SE

Mission: Provides food baskets to those in need (as many as 30/day); recipients are eligible 1/month.

Donations: It is best to bring donations in during first hour of distribution to the produce can be distributed ASAP.

St. Mary's Soup Kitchen, 728 Ellsworth SW

Mission: Hot meals served three times a week to anyone in need. They serve between 80 and 250 people per night (more are served toward the end of the month).

Donations: They will gladly accept fresh produce!

Sweet Home

Sweet Home Emergency Ministries: Manna Kitchen, 845 6th Ave.

Mission: Provides a meal once a week to anyone in need.

Donations: If they receive more produce then they can put into a meal, they will sent recipients home with food for later in the week!

Lebanon

Lebanon Soup Kitchen: First Christian Church, 170 East Grant St.

Mission: provides a meal three times a week to anyone in need. About 5% of their recipients are homeless.

Donations: It is better to donate produce earlier in the day, so they can incorporate it into the meal. If they receive more produce than they need, they will donate it to the Lord's Store House.
