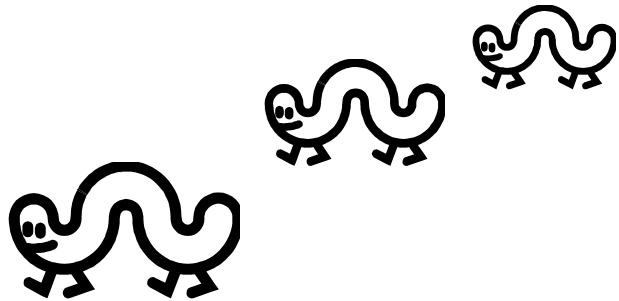
**Workshop participants will receive:** One preassembled worm bin, starter worms, bedding mix, 1 ½ hours of instruction, and follow-up support.
