Challenge Leadership Programs:

Campers who have completed 7th & 8th grades will have the chance to join in specially designed leadership and team-building activities. These may include a challenge rope course, field trips, and a special camp-out.

- ◆ **Staff** are highly trained volunteers working year-long to provide a safe and nurturing environment while dedicated to the personal growth of youth.
- ◆ **Counselors** are high school students who have completed over 30 hours of Counselor Training and are assigned to cabins of 6-12 campers
- ◆ A **camp nurse** is on duty 24 hours a day.
- ◆ A **certified lifeguard** is stationed at the pool and ponds during all water activities.
- ◆ The **experienced kitchen staff** prepares three nutritious meals a day.

Cost: \$329.00

- ◆ A deposit of \$120.00 must accompany the registration and the balance due on the first day of camp.
