Projects and Events

- **Red Alder Inventory Plots**
Come learning how to establish inventory plots as OSU Extension Forester Glenn Ahrens along with his team of volunteers begins to assess the Red Alder Management Area on the Post Property.
- **Tree Planting**
Learn proper planting technique and seedling maintenance/protection while inter-planting western red cedar in our 2015 harvest area adjacent to the riparian buffer.
- **Right-o-Way Limb Removal**
