Projects and Events (NOTE: Some activities have changed, we will make groups assignments after people arrive)

- **East Watershed Loop Bridge Repair**
The tree that landed on the bridge was milled-up and now we need to use that lumber to replace the deck. So since the tree gave back, all the hard feelings we had for it are 'water under the bridge'... Speaking of water, you might want a pair of good waterproof boots if you are assigned this task (we have a few pairs here too).
- **Hopkins Hall to Grouse Hollow Road, Stairs Installation**
We are going to construct a set of stairs to connect the back of Hopkins Hall to Grouse Hollow Road using guardrail ties. We are going to use some forestry tools to measure the needed rise and run. If you are 'level' minded, a bit of a 'square' and think you can make the 'grade'... This is the job for you.
- **Lumber Manufacturing**
We still have many saw logs up top next to the Mill House ready to become boards. While we have some boards already cut, I would like to mill some more for doing the bridge repair and cut some so we can create a few benches for the forest. However their will not be any sitting down on the job.
- **Forest Inventory**
We are hoping for a great turnout this Saturday and want to have a small crew head into the forest and work on doing some inventory and stocking assessments. We have all the gear, but bring some good clothing for the field.
