## **SERVICE AWARDS**

A plaque will be awarded to the large club, small club and individual who has earned the most points by doing various jobs around the grounds as listed on a job list. Jobs will be for areas that are used by all but not included in any club's herdsmanship area. A large club is defined as a club with 10 or more members showing at fair and a small club has 9 or fewer members showing at fair. Individuals may be members of a club but chose to earn points on an individual basis. When a job is selected from the job list, members must indicate if they are participating as part of a club or earning individual points. An individual may earn points as an individual on one job and as a club member on another job. To earn points for a club, the job must be completed by 3 or more members if from a large club or at least 2 members if from a small club. The job list will be posted at the 4-H Fair Office.

# HORSE

Number of entries and/or ribbons received for those entries will not be a consideration for this award. The award will be presented during special fair award presentations on the last day of fair.

**Outstanding 4-H Horse Member - Jamie Nelson Memorial** – Golubickas Family, Sponsor

A combination of the following will be considered in the outstanding horse member award: Ribbon points from highest equitation performance, showmanship score as given by the judge, horse judging %, presentation ribbon points. The primary leader from each livestock club will nominate one 4-H livestock member from any livestock club. A committee composed of the 4-H livestock fair superintendents and the barn superintendent will make the final selection. Number of entries and/or ribbons received for those entries will not be a consideration for this award. The award will be presented during special fair award presentation on the last day of fair.

## **Market Animals: Rate of Gain** – Junior Market Auction Committee, Sponsor

Awards will be made to the "top gain" animals from 4-H or FFA in the beef, sheep, swine, and goat market animal program. Animals must be judged a blue ribbon by the show judge to be eligible.

## **Grand Champion Market Animal** – Clatsop Co. Livestock Assoc., Sponsor

An award will be presented at a later date to the owners of the grand champion beef, sheep, swine, and goat from 4-H or FFA in the market animal program.

## **Herdsmanship, 10 and over members** – H. Howell's Memory, Oregon Hunter's Association, Sponsor

Rotating trophy awarded to the club with 10 or more members showing at the fair who score highest in herdsmanship. Beef, sheep, dairy, dairy goats, pygmy goats and swine clubs eligible.
