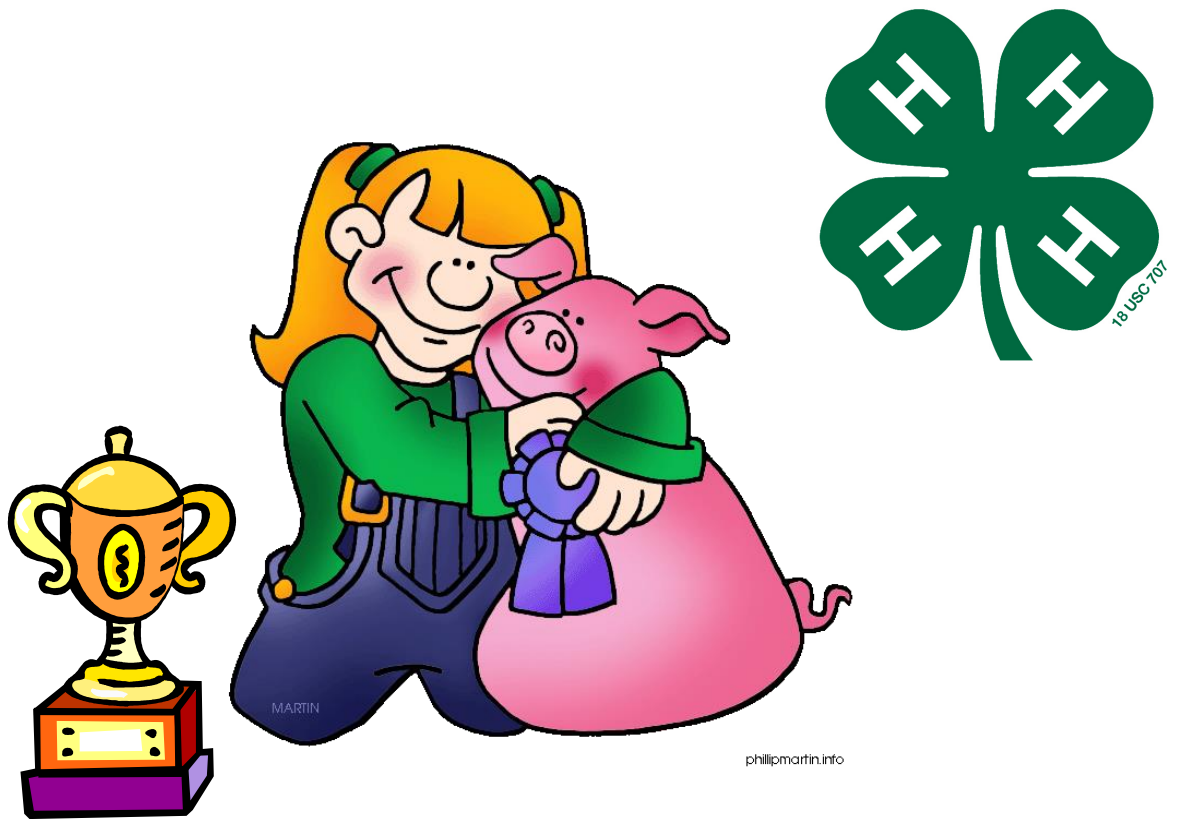


4-H Fair Awards

SERVICE AWARDS

A plaque will be awarded to the large club, small club, and individual who has earned the most points by doing various jobs around the grounds as listed on a job list. Jobs will be for areas, which are used by all but, not included in any club's herdsmanship area. A large club is defined as a club with 10 or more members showing at fair and a small club has 9 or fewer members showing at the fair. Individuals may be members of a club but chose to earn points on an individual basis. When a job is selected from the job list, members must indicate if they are participating as part of a club or earning individual points. An individual may earn points as an individual on one job and as a club member on another job. To earn points for a club, 3 or more members if from a large club or at least 2 members if from a small club must complete the job. The job list will be posted at the 4-H Fair Office.

An award will be given to the Intermediate/Senior Champion Knitting or Crocheting exhibit as chosen by the judge. Outstanding Fiber Arts Exhibitor – Lacy Family, Sponsor

A permanent trophy will be awarded to the outstanding Fiber Arts exhibitor from any age division. Dairy Awards - Oregon Dairy Women, Sponsor

Scoring will take into consideration the maximum number of class entries allowed in each age division.

HORSE

For purposes of these awards, the term "score" shall refer to the number given by the judge to the participant during competition. The term "ribbon points" shall refer to the numerical value of the ribbon awarded by the judge to the participant. (Champion, 5 points; Reserve Champion, 4 points; Blue, 3 points; Red, 2 points; White, 1 point)

Note: 1st tiebreaker - Trail; 2nd tiebreaker - Horse Judging

The primary leader of each horse club will nominate one 4-H horse member from any horse club. A committee composed of the 4-H horse superintendent, the barn superintendent, and one OSU Extension faculty will make the final selection. A number of entries and/or ribbons received for those entries will not be a consideration for this award. The award will be presented during special fair award presentations on the last day of fair.

Outstanding 4-H Horse Member - Jamie Nelson Memorial – Golubickas Family, Sponsor

A combination of the following will be considered in the outstanding horse member award: Ribbon points from highest equitation performance, showmanship score as given by the judge, horse judging %, presentation ribbon points. The tiebreaker is Trail. The individual scoring the highest total of this combination will be the recipient of a rotating and permanent trophy.

Hi-Point Trail – Brim’s Farm & Garden, Sponsor

A permanent trophy will be presented to the 4-H'er from any age group (Novice, Jr., Int., or Sr.) with the top score as given by the judge in Trail. Tie Breaker will be Horse Judging.

Hi-Point Equitation Over Fences – Brim's Farm & Garden, Sponsor

A trophy will be presented to the 4-H'er from any age group (Novice, Jr., Int., or Sr.) with the top score as given by the judge in Equitation Over Fences.

Hi-Point Dressage – Mea-Lin Morgans, The Harn Family, Sponsor

A rotating trophy and gift will be presented to the member of any age group who receives the highest score in dressage competition.

Hi-Point Gaming – Pacific Coast Seafood, Sponsor

A rotating trophy will be presented to the member of any age group who receives the highest accumulative score from all gaming events.

Hi-Point Driving - Columbia Veterinary Hospital, Sponsor

A permanent trophy will be presented to the member of any age group who receives the highest score in the driving competition.

Hi-Point Academy Award – Little Bear Creek Ranch, Sponsor

A belt buckle will be presented to the member of any age group who receives the highest accumulative score from all academy classes.

Hi-Point Walk-Trot – The Ship Inn, Sponsor

A belt buckle will be awarded to the individual with the highest walk-trot score as given by the judge.

Hi-Point Novice – LGJ Livestock, Sponsor

A belt buckle will be awarded to the Novice with the highest combination of scores as given by the judge. Combined scores will include the individual's highest equitation score, showmanship score, and Trail score. Tiebreaker will be horse judging score.

Hi-Point Junior – Aydtt Family, Sponsor

A belt buckle will be awarded to the Junior with the highest combination of scores as given by the judge. Combined scores will include the individual's highest equitation score, showmanship score, and Trail score. Tiebreaker will be horse judging score.

Hi-Point Intermediate – Astoria Dairy Queen, Sponsor

A belt buckle will be awarded to the Intermediate with the highest combination of scores as given by the judge. Combined scores will include the individual's highest equitation score, showmanship score, and Trail score. Tiebreaker will be horse judging score.

Hi-Point Senior – Jerry & Susan Widawski, Sponsor

A belt buckle will be awarded to the Senior with the highest combination of scores as given by the judge. Combined scores will include the individual's highest equitation score, showmanship score, and Trail score. Tiebreaker will be horse judging.

Hi-Point Horse Showman – Scarborough Family, Sponsor

A permanent trophy will be given to the horse showman from any age group who received the highest showmanship score as given by the judge. Judge's choice if tied scores.

Hi-Point Horse Judging – Pacific Coast Seafood, Sponsors

A permanent trophy will be awarded to the individual with the highest score in the horse judging contest. (Novice, Junior, Int., and Senior combined)

Reserve Hi-Point Horse Judging – Scott & Tammy Olds, Sponsors

A permanent trophy will be awarded to the individual with the 2nd highest score in the horse judging contest. (Novice, Junior, Intermediate and Senior combined)

Horse Herdsmanship – Julie George, Sponsor

A plaque and rotating trophy will be awarded to the club, which scores highest in herdsmanship. A club must have at least two members exhibiting to qualify.

Stall Decorations – Chris Hoffman, Sponsor

A plaque and cash award will be awarded to the club winning the stall decoration competition based on the Judge's decision. The theme should follow the fair theme.

Medallion Class – Clatsop County 4-H Horse Leaders; L.J. Allen Construction; Tammy Olds; Tonya Lempea; Guenther Family, and Nygaard Family, Sponsors

The Champion and Reserve Champion Novice, Junior, Intermediate and Senior in Western, Saddle, and Hunt Seat equitation shall enter the medallion class. The top three riders as chosen by the judge shall each receive identical medallions and chest ribbons for their horses.

LIVESTOCK

Grand Champion Livestock Showman – Bob Reed Memorial, Sponsor

The Grand Champion Livestock Showman (Int/Sr) in beef, sheep, swine, dairy, goats and pygmy goats will participate in a Round Robin Showmanship contest where each showman will show all six classes of livestock. A rotating and a permanent trophy will be awarded to the winner of this contest.

Reserve Grand Champion Livestock Showman – Tuveng Family, Sponsor

A rotating trophy will be awarded to the Reserve Grand Champion Livestock Showman from the Round Robin Showmanship contest.



Sportsmanship Award - in Mitch Groat's Memory – Lou Ann Tucker, Sponsor

A rotating and a permanent trophy will be awarded to a 4-H member in the livestock area (beef, sheep, swine, dairy cattle and goats) based on the following during the County Fair.

The primary leader of each livestock club will nominate one 4-H livestock member from any livestock club. A committee composed of the 4-H livestock fair superintendents and the barn superintendent will make the final selection. A number of entries and/or ribbons received for those entries will not be a consideration for this award. The award will be presented during special fair award presentation on the last day of fair.

Market Animals: Rate of Gain – Clatsop County Junior Livestock Auction Committee, Sponsor

Awards will be made to the "top gain" animals from 4-H or FFA in the beef, sheep, swine, and goat market animal program. Animals must be judged a blue ribbon by the show judge to be eligible.

Herdsmanship, 10 and over members – H. Howell's Memory, Nettie & Philip Blair Family, Sponsor

Rotating trophy awarded to the club with 10 or more members showing at the fair who score highest in herdsmanship. Beef, sheep, dairy, dairy goats, pygmy goats and swine clubs eligible.

Herdsmanship, 9 and under members – Nettie & Philip Blair Family, Sponsor

Rotating trophy awarded to the club with 9 or fewer members showing at the fair who score highest in herdsmanship. Beef, sheep, dairy, dairy goats, pygmy goats and swine clubs eligible. A club must have at least 2 members exhibiting to be eligible.
