

# Green Industry Professional Training



The Green Industry Professional training targets individuals interested in learning research-based gardening information specific to this area. This training is ideal for individuals that work in the horticultural industry and want to further their education, but are unable to complete the entire Master Gardener™ program due to work or other commitments. This classroom training is combined with the first part of our OSU Master Gardener™ certification program. It includes weekly training conducted by qualified OSU Extension faculty, specialists, and veteran OSU Master Gardeners™. Topics include: cold climate gardening techniques, soils, basic botany, plant disease, insects, weeds, turfgrass, xeriscaping, integrated pest management, vegetables, and pesticide safety.
