SmART PARTNERS

Bureau of Land Management (BLM): Carries out a variety of programs for the management and conservation of resources on 258 million surface acres. Manages rangeland and provides grazing permits & leases.

Central Oregon Intergovernmental Council (COIC): Assists landowners with implementing renewable energy and energy efficiency projects; niche and direct marketing for agricultural products; and cost-share, grant and loan programs.

Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs (CTWS): The tribal economy is based primarily on natural resources, including hydropower, forest products and ranching. Tourism and recreation also make important contributions.

County Weed & Vegetation Management: Promotes and implements noxious weed control and education in identification & control. Cost share program available.

Deschutes River Conservancy (DRC): Works to restore stream flow and improve water quality in the Deschutes Basin. Water banking, stream flow restoration, partnerships and project cost share.

Farm Service Agency (FSA): Serves all farmers, ranchers and agricultural partners & provides federal program benefits such as loans for operating and land purchase, commodity price support, disaster relief, and conservation.

Irrigation Districts: Maintain irrigation systems to preserve the capacity and condition to ensure adequate storage and delivery of irrigation water when required by water users with a continual program of preventive maintenance.

Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS): Assists private landowners and managers in conserving their soil and natural resources. Provides information on soil types, soil mapping and interpretation. Administers and provides assistance with cost share programs with a variety of natural resource concerns.

Oregon Dept. of Agriculture (ODA): Promotes and regulates agriculture. Helps landowners prevent and control water pollution from agriculture, advises on livestock and manure management, controls noxious weeds, regulates plant nurseries, conducts brand inspections and more.

Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife (ODFW): Source of information on fish, wildlife and habitat management. Provides needed information on fishing, hunting and viewing opportunities for both private and public lands and waters.

Oregon State University Extension Service: Provides research based information in the areas of livestock, crops, horticulture, small farms and acreages as well as forestry and natural resources, home garden and landscape, family and community development, nutrition education and 4-H youth development.

Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF): Manages and promotes stewardship of Oregon's forests to enhance environmental, economic, and community sustainability.

Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board: Provides funding for watershed enhancement projects under the general categories of education, monitoring, management and assessment/action planning.

Oregon Water Resources Department: Serves the public by practicing and promoting responsible water management through addressing water supply needs and to restore and protect stream-flows and watersheds.

Soil & Water Conservation Districts: Conservation of renewable resources including conservation and development of water resources and water quality and preserving wildlife. Prepares management plans and helps implement them.

US Fish & Wildlife: Conserves, protects, and enhances the nation's fish and wildlife and their habitats for the continuing benefit of people.

Watershed Councils: Brings diverse interests together to work towards solutions on local natural resource issues. Develops and funds watershed enhancement projects and provides education.
