Notice to all Home Economics and Expressive Art Clubs:

The Umpqua Valley Quilters Guild is offering 2 awards of \$75 each toward the purchase of quilting supplies to construct a quilt for exhibit. The quilt must be displayed at the Umpqua Valley Quilters Show in April and exhibited at the next year's Douglas County Fair.

The purpose of this award is to promote and encourage 4-H youth in Douglas County to develop their sewing and quilting skills. Any 4-H member in 5th grade or above may submit an application.

All applications must be in the Extension Office, PO Box 1165, Roseburg, OR. 97470, by **5:00 p.m., October 1.**

Terms of the Award

1. Applicants must be currently enrolled as 4-H members
2. Two awards of \$75 each will be presented each year.
3. Applicants must be presently in the 5th grade or older and have at least one year experience in 4-H.
4. Application will consist of:
 - a) Current year's 4-H records which ended September 30 (assembled according to respective guidelines).
 - b) Short essay which includes the following:
 - Why you are interested in the quilting project
 - The purpose of the quilt. – What will it be used for?
 - Include an easy sketch of the planned quilt.
5. Winners must agree to display the quilt at the next year's Umpqua Valley Quilters Show in April (can be a work in progress) and exhibit the quilt at the Douglas County Fair.
6. Selection committee shall be comprised of members of the Umpqua Valley Quilters Guild.
7. Winners will be announced at the 4-H Recognition Festival. Quilting supplies must be purchased within 90 days of award.
8. Winners of this award shall write a letter to the sponsor and keep them updated on the progress of the quilts. Members of the Quilters Guild are available to help the winners plan their quilt and purchase supplies. The award winners must notify the 4-H Awards Committee if they are unable to accept the award, if they must give it up or if they move from the area.
