



4-H DOUGLAS COUNTY SCHOLARSHIP 2007



Scholarship Eligibility:

- Applicant must be a high school senior or a student who graduated from a Douglas County high school or equivalent form of education in Douglas County.
- Applicant must plan to attend a community college, vocational-technical school or a four-year college/university that will lead to a college degree or license.
- Applicant must have at least three years of 4-H experience, with at least one year in Douglas County.

Amount of award: \$500* (up to three \$500 awards will be given in 2007)

Application due date: 5pm on Friday, March 2, 2007, in the Roseburg OSU Extension Office

The recipient of the 4-H Douglas County Scholarship will be selected based on the following criteria:

- 4-H experience (40 points)
- Academic achievement and community involvement (35 points)
- Financial statement (15 points)
- Application - complete, neat, organized (10 points)

The 5 top scoring applicants will be invited to participate in an interview with the Scholarship Committee**. The scholarship recipient(s) will be selected based on his/her application and interview***.

- Interview (date will be scheduled during the week of spring break - March 26-30)

Enclose the following (any application that is not complete as described below will not be reviewed):

1. Completed application
2. Personal statement
3. Transcript showing your classes and grades
4. Include three (3) letters of recommendation with your application, one of which is to be from someone related to your 4-H experience (excluding 4-H agent)

Katherine Cory

A portion of the Douglas County 4-H Scholarship endowment came from a fund that was set up in memory of Katherine Cory. Katherine Cory was a beloved individual who served as a Douglas County 4-H leader for over 50 years. She started her first 4-H club in 1927, teaching a small group of children to sew. During her 4-H career, she also taught cooking, forestry, livestock, health and safety, and horticulture projects. She was a teacher at the Callahan log school as well as in Lookingglass, Dillard and Winston schools. During her life, Katherine and her husband Ralph were parents to 18 foster children.

*Requests for a one-year deferral of scholarship funds are allowed and are at the discretion of the Douglas County 4-H Scholarship Committee.

**The Douglas County 4-H Scholarship Committee will make final decisions on awarding the scholarship. The committee may choose not to award the scholarship if funds are not available or if the quality of applicants does not warrant the award.

*** Applicants who were awarded the scholarship previously are eligible to apply again. However, preference will be given to those applicants who have not received the scholarship.
