Purpose of Fair Kitchen:

1. To provide daily, inexpensive, nutritious meals for 4-H participants and their families
2. To raise a modest sum of money from the general public to support the county 4-H programs, its members and leaders. This project is the **ONLY MEANS OF EARNING FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE 4-H PROGRAM EACH YEAR.** (Workshops, clinics, recognition, judging teams, etc.)
