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- May 9                      Codling moth traps have no moths. Do not spray yet. Wait until the trap gets 5 moths within one week before spraying.
- May 16                     Codling moth trap catch jumped to 8 moths on Saturday. You should start your spray program within the next week.
- May 23                     Codling moth count jumped to big numbers following our hot spell last week. Make sure you apply your first spray. Some recommended products for homeowners are Spinosad, Kaolin clay, horticultural oil, or Cyd-X virus. No sign of apple scab in the orchard but I did notice this past week some new shoots with powdery mildew. Applying a fungicide spray with immunox, pristine, sulfur, or neem oil a good idea
- May 30                     No codling moths were trapped. No sign of any apple scab on trees. Cherry fruit fly maggots are popping up locally this year so a spray of Spinosad, or Malathion will be timely
- June 6                     A few codling moths were trapped but not enough to warrant sprays. More Cherry fruit flies being trapped so make sure you made a control application.
- June 13                    Just a few codling moths were caught in the traps. Do not spray yet. Hold off until you get at least five moths in the trap all caught within that week.
- June 20                    I caught 3 codling moths in several traps so continue to hold off spraying.
- June 27                    We are trapping more codling moths this week so it is advisable to apply controls sometime between June 24 and July 2. If you used Spinosad twice already change to Cyd-X virus or Kaolin clay which is called Surround.
- July 4                     No new codling moths were trapped this week. Start to monitor Filbert worm and Walnut Husk Fly. None of these two showed up in traps this week.
- July 11                    Five new codling moths were trapped during the past week. It would be a good time to make one last spray for Codling Moth within the next week. No Filbert Worm or Walnut Husk Flies were trapped this week.

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- July 18                      No new moths trapped this week.
- July 25                      Two Filbert worms were trapped this week. When the extremely hot temperatures subside back into the 80's or low 90's then apply your first filbert worm spray. Homeowners can use Spinosad or Malathion for worm control.
- August 1                    Walnut husk flies were trapped this week. Homeowners can use Spinosad or Malathion for worm control.

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
