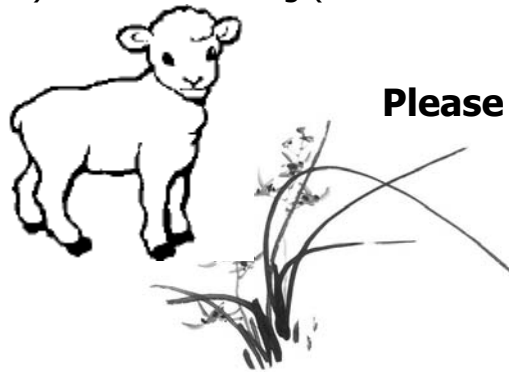


FORAGE QUALITY:
