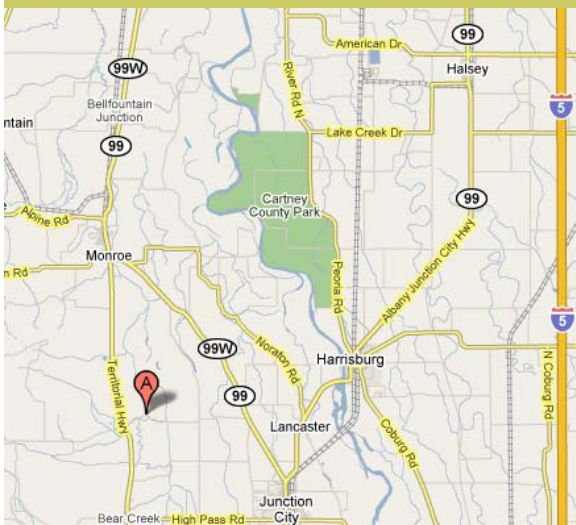
From Corvallis
