Sheep Safety and Quality Assurance (SSQA) Level 1 training sessions are being offered throughout Oregon. Level 1 (Participation) is the 1st of 3 levels or phases of the SSQA program.

Training in Level 1 of the Sheep Quality Assurance Programs implies that a producer has been educated in the principles and logic of the program and that they understand the importance of the program objectives. Upon successful completion of Level 1 training, Level 2 (Certification) may be achieved. This is followed by Level 3 (Verification).

The SSQA program is the national quality assurance program for the U.S. Sheep Industry sponsored by ASI. The program was developed to ensure that consumer products generated by the U.S. Sheep Industry are safe and of the highest quality possible.

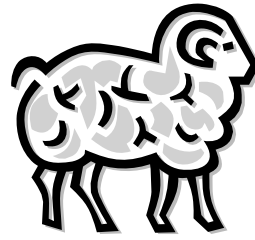
