

Supreme Champion Market Breeding Animal Fair Award

Purpose:

To promote a breeding programs for market animals.

Guidelines:

1. Animals participating in this award: **Beef, Sheep, Swine, Meat Goats**
2. Exhibitors must be actively involved in the breeding project and be in possession of breeding project animals by October 1.
3. To participate in the Supreme Champion Market Breeding Animal Fair Award:
 - a. First determine which of your breeding animals will be submitted for the award.
 - b. Prepare paper work to support your entry.
 - c. Submit paper work to the respective Fair Superintendents on Tuesday of Fair.
Paper work includes:
 1. Intent to Participate
 2. 4-H Production Records (**make copy before turning in record book**)
 3. Feed and Growth Records (**make copy before turning in record book**)
4. 4-H members must pre-determine before fair which animal they will use to enter the Supreme Champion Market Breeding Award. The animal must be exhibited and judged at the Hood River County Fair and meet the respective fair book class requirements.
5. All breeds of the same species compete together. Both male and females compete together. All animals entered in the special class will compete for this award.
6. For goats to be eligible to enter, they must be entered in fair under the Meat Goat Division.
7. Selection based on:

60%	Conformation of the Animal
40%	Production Capabilities (demonstrated through production records)
8. All animals who meet the qualifications are able to participate in the Supreme Champion Market Breeding Animal Fair Award, regardless of the class placing.
