Providing a Youth Scholarship will help Lane County 4-H members attend out-of-county events like:

- Summer Conference - community service, leadership camp.
- National 4-H Congress - community service, leadership and recognition.
- Project Area Training - for all program areas.
- Know Your State Government - A 3-day educational program at the State Capitol.

### **Youth Fair 4-H Recognition Awards**

The purpose of 4-H Awards is to provide recognition of members' achievements and personal growth through their 4-H work. During the Youth Fair, all members receive recognition for their efforts by having their exhibits, contests and showmanship evaluated. 4-Hers receive either a champion, reserve champion, medallion, blue, red or white ribbon for their accomplishments and may be eligible for special awards (e.g. chairs, tack, trophies...etc.).

4-H Recognition Award sponsors are needed for all project areas. You may specify a project area to support or contribute to the General Youth Fair Recognition Program.

Over 7 million children participate in 4-H nationally. Oregon reached over 101,000 school age youth in 2004-05 with 7,871 4-H adult volunteers. Lane County is one of the 36 counties in the state of Oregon. 9,489 youth participated in the Lane County program during the 2004-05 4-H year.
