



## Lincoln County 4-H College Scholarships

The following Lincoln County 4-H Scholarships are available for high school graduates in 2009. Please read the criteria and application requirements carefully.

### June Neigebauer Memorial Scholarship

- This scholarship is available to any enrolled 4-Her who is a graduating senior in high school and has been involved in 4-H for three years. It is to assist a student with education expenses after high school.
- **Emphasis:** Leadership, Citizenship/Community Service, 4-H accomplishments and school records.

### Rocky Lockler Memorial Scholarship

- This scholarship is offered to graduating seniors with **at least three years in the Lincoln County 4-H Animal Science program**, horse not applicable.
- **Emphasis:** Recognition of meritorious work and achievement in 4-H, especially an animal science project, that shows leadership, character development, and citizenship. Applicant must submit “explanation of financial need” included with application, as financial need will be part of the selection criteria.

### Everett and Gladys Barclay Endowed Scholarship

- This scholarship is offered to Lincoln County graduating seniors with at least three years membership in Lincoln County 4-H program at the 4-H senior level.
- **Emphasis:** Recognition of meritorious work and achievement in 4-H projects that show leadership, character development, and citizenship. First priority will be given to South County Applicants.

### Application Requirements

1. Applicants must be properly enrolled (enrollment forms completed, insurance paid and current “Official 4-H Registration” on file in the Extension Office) in the Lincoln County 4-H program by February 14<sup>th</sup> in order to be eligible for these scholarship awards.
2. Completed application form
3. Essay (minimum 750 words) **Topic:** How 4-H has influenced your future life plans and why you are pursuing more education.
4. Up-to-date 4-H Permanent Record
5. School transcript with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA or an official copy of SAT/ACT scores
6. Last year’s project records
7. 2 separate letters of recommendation (not from a parent)
8. Personal Interview to be scheduled ( You **must submit 3 TOTAL** complete copies of 2,3,4,5,6 &7, regardless of how many applications you are submitting)
