How do I sign-up?

- Fill out the enclosed camper registration form and the 4-H Code of Conduct form.
- Send the camp fee of \$195.00 for regular campers or \$255.00 for horse campers to: Linn County OSU Extension. (Checks made payable to Linn County 4-H Leader's Association.)
- Camp will be one day longer this year, but we have managed to keep the cost the same. We hope you enjoy the extra day of jungle fun!
- Most importantly....do this soon because registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Registration ends May 22rd. (But, if you are late, call 541-967-3871 to see if there is still room.)
- At the beginning of June you'll receive a Welcome Letter giving you all the details you'll need to know such as times to arrive and what to bring.

Other details...

- **Refund Policy:** Full refunds will be made for cancellations through May 22, 2009. After that date, only \$50.00 will be refunded. No refunds will be given once camp begins.
- **Scholarships:** Some scholarships may be available. Contact your 4-H Extension Office for further details & deadline information.
