Each member must provide their own equipment including quivers to hold their arrows during the contest. All members are required to follow the Official 4-H Code of Conduct and display good sportsmanship. We are here to have fun and show new skills. Participants are **required** to compute records and attend one safety meeting (with their leader), in order to shoot at Fair.

Bare Bow Compound archers do not use sights or mechanical releases or other attachments on their bows. No maximum bow weight. Gloves, fingertabs and arm guards are permitted.
