1. All exhibitors are required to have their dogs currently vaccinated against Rabies, DHL or DHLP, Parvo Virus and bordetella.
2. All dogs must have attended and passed a Pre-Fair Safety Check
3. All dogs must be kept "on lead" while on the fairgrounds and you are responsible for picking up after your dog.
4. A 4-H member may enter a (1) dog in each Obedience class available. The same dog may be entered in only one obedience class, but may also be entered in Brace and/or one Team Class. Intermediate and senior members are eligible for State Fair. (Refer to State Fair Book)
5. ***New*** Exhibitors must train, show or exhibit dogs they have owned and personally trained 90 days prior to the County and State Fair. April 9th is the deadline for Linn County Fair. A written training agreement must be on file with the OSU Extension Linn County office by April 9th, 2010 for all leased animals.
6. Record books are required to participate at the Linn County Fair
7. Per Animal Show Policies - Showmanship. All exhibitors must participate in Showmanship in each project area entered. Failure to participate in Showmanship, disqualifies State Fair eligibility and forfeits Obedience Awards. For complete instructions see 4-H Dog Obedience, Showmanship and Contest Guide (4-H 1202). Available at the Extension Office.
8. Showmanship animals must also be entered and shown in an obedience class.
9. 1st Year Members must use the same project animal for both obedience and showmanship.
