1. All fitting and showing must be done by the individual.
2. All tack will be in tack stalls assigned in club sections. No hay bales in the aisles.
3. Members may not enter more than nine animals of two different breeds (breeding stock).
4. Market animal may be crossbred and not counted as a third breed.
5. There must be three or more animals of a breed to constitute a breed division.
6. Animals must have been washed and preliminary clipping must be done prior to Fair, except long wool breeds.
7. Market lambs cannot be shown in breeding classes except as ewe and produce.
8. Remove all market ear tags from breeding animals.
9. All sheep must comply with the state scrapie rule. Tags must be in each animal's ear.
10. **Blankets must be off sheep Tuesday night for the vet check**

1. Must weigh at least 110 lbs. on Tuesday of Fair week. They must weigh less than 110 lbs at May weigh-in. There is no top weight limit.
2. Must have at least ¼ lb. ADG for last 60 days to sell at auction.
3. Sex may be either ewe or wether.

4. Market animal must be shown in no more than ¼" fleece and superintendent may require shearing before weighing if over ¼" fleece.

5. Male animals must be castrated by first weigh-in.

6. Animal must be less than 1 year old at Fair time.

771 700 040 Club/Chapter Flock (County only) -a flock consisting of five females with at least three owners from the same 4-H/FFA club. The flock will be judged on uniformity and quality of exhibits. Clubs can show more than one flock.
