## **Water Taste Test**

#### You will need:

- ◆ Five different samples of drinking water from 5 different sources (from tap, from another community source, bottled, etc.). Have the samples all at room temperature and provide about 3 ounces per person.
- ♦ 3-ounce bathroom cups
- Analysis sheets

#### Procedure:

- 1. Label each water sample (A, B, C, D, E). Only you should know which water is which.
- 2. Have each student taste each sample and record results on the analysis sheet.
- 3. Compare results from the group.
- 4. Speculate on what could account for differences in taste. For example, many store-purchased waters are sold in plastic containers which often tend to impart a taste to the water.
