4-H Mini Grant Application - 2021-2022

OSU Extension 4-H and the Washington County 4-H Association annually raises funds to offer 4-H Mini Grants. Clubs currently enrolled with Washington County 4-H are eligible to apply for a grant of \$50-\$200 per year. Only one grant per club is allowed per year. This includes a separate request by a club or in collaboration with another club. Funding is available for projects that: 1) meet the 4-H mission (citizenship, healthy living and science), 2) are created and led by 4-H members, and 3) encourage participation of 4-H members. A completed grant application, presentation and display/presentation of completed project is required for the grant. Applicants will be notified of their time to present a five minute presentation to explain their application to the Mini Grant Committee. All 4-H members involved in the project are required to participate in the presentation unless an absence is approved in advance of the presentation.

Applicants will be notified of the Mini Grant Committee decision by an e-mail and phone call within a week of a presentation to the committee. A presentation or poster board display reflecting completion of the project is required at the First Wednesday or All Leader meeting in September, unless an extension is requested.
