Herdsmanship

The 4-H Herdsmanship Contest is to help 4-H members learn skills in making a presentable exhibit for the public as well as learn skills in courtesy, cooperation, neatness and proper care of animals.

Basis for scoring:

- 1. Herdsmanship will be judged from 9:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday of Fair. Herdsmanship will not be judged during species show or the livestock judging contest.
- 2. All waste, manure and straw should be placed in designated area by 7:45 a.m. each day.
- 3. Beef, sheep, goats, swine, rabbits, poultry, horse and dairy exhibits will be judged for herdsmanship.
- 4. Herdsmanship will be judged on a club basis. Individual herdsmanship is mandatory. Premiums will be paid on an individual basis according to club results, and as determined by standard premium point values. (See General Rules section.)
- 5. Club herdsmanship awards will be announced daily.
- 6. All pens and stalls are to be identified.

Livestock Animal Judging and Identification Contest

- 6. No prior fair experience and Junior class will comprise one class, Intermediate and Senior will comprise another separate class.
