Weeds Identification and Control

This class will help you identify spring emergent weeds and prioritize their removal. Bring your weeds to this class for ID! We will look at methods that allow you to quickly turn weeds into worm food and eliminate weed seeds from your soils, so your spring weeding becomes quick and easy without using herbicides.
