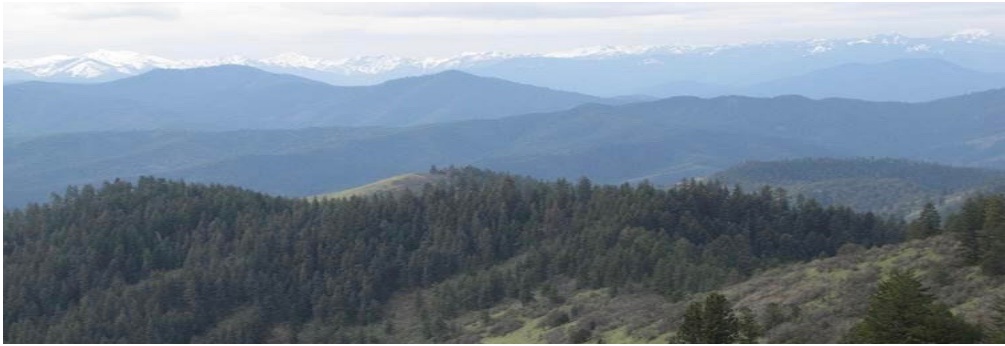




Jackson Josephine Small Woodlands Association Annual Meeting and Dinner
