

# **Job Description for the Jackson County Youth Livestock Ambassadors**

**Purpose:**

The purpose of the Youth Livestock Ambassadors is to:

- serve as an ambassador for the 4-H/FFA auction program to the community.
- assist the auction committee in improving the quality of the Jackson County livestock auctions.
- serve in a leadership role in the beef, sheep, and swine projects before & during the fairs.

**Expectations of Committee Members:**

5 - 10 youth are needed who have demonstrated:

- a willingness and ability to commit time and energy to tasks.
- an ability to work cooperatively with others.
- the capacity to make decisions, take charge, and follow-through with limited supervision.
- public speaking skills.

**Time Commitment:**

Youth are asked to serve a one-year term.

**Who can Apply:**

Jackson County 4-H or FFA members in the 11th or 12th grade may apply.

**How to Apply:**

- Complete an application by Thursday January 11th.
- Schedule an interview by Thursday January 11<sup>th</sup>.
