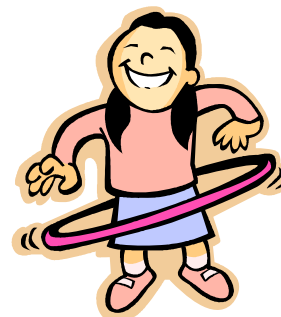

**Important Information for Parents:** The registration fee includes enrollment in 4-H, supplies, and accident insurance. Students may ride a school bus to the OSU Extension Office with a note from their parents. **Parents are responsible for transportation home for students. Students must be picked up no later than 5:15 p.m.** After-school participants are eligible to participate in 4-H activities throughout the year. Contact the OSU Extension Office, 2204 Fourth Street, Tillamook, (503) 842-3433 with questions. To register your child, complete a 4-H enrollment form listing babysitter training as the club, and turn it in with payment at the OSU Extension Office, 2204 Fourth Street, Tillamook, 503-842-3433. Payment accepted via cash, check (payable to the OSU Extension Service) or debit/credit card. Pre-registration is required. Financial need scholarships available upon request.

**4-H Activities Refund Information:** 100% of the registration fee paid will be refunded if cancellation is requested 10 business days or more before the activity. 50% of the fee will be refunded if cancellation occurs 5 to 9 business days before the activity begins. No refunds will be made when cancellation occurs within 4 business days of the activity or participant fails to show up for the activity.
