★ To be eligible for this show, exhibitors MUST bring their livestock to the designated weigh-in location at the designated time to be officially tagged.		

Each show is governed by a separate show board and each show has a pre-show registration in addition to the possession/weigh dates.

The eligibility weights for all three shows will be the unshrunk weight across the scales. Sale weights will be determined by subtracting a 3% pencil shrink on all livestock.

Lambs do not need to be shorn for pre-show weigh-ins. ***Umatilla County Fair and Pendleton Junior Show lambs must be slick shorn at the show.***

All lambs and goats being exhibited **must have an approved scrapie tag or tattoo** at the show.

Make sure that the weigh-in slips are filled out completely. Please be prepared with the following information: name, address, phone number, grade, description of animal, sex of animal, 4-H or FFA, name of club or chapter, and indicate which show(s) the animal is being weighed in for. Please specify each family member's name and grade, if animal is being weighed under a family name, (i.e. the Doe kids are weighing in two hogs, each weigh slip should say, Jane 10th grade and John 5th grade). Each exhibitor should keep a copy of each weigh-in slip.
