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Refund Policy:

FULL REFUNDS will only be issued for any cancelations made two weeks (14 days) prior to the event.

PARTIAL REFUNDS will only be issued for cancelations made within 2-14 days prior to the event. There will be a \$90 withholding for a two-day registration cancellation (Chemical Applicator and Non Crop Vegetation Management Courses ONLY) or \$50 withholding for a one-day registration cancellation (Chemical Applicator 1 - day, Non Crop Vegetation Management 1 - day, Central Oregon Pest Management Course, Urban Pest Management Course, and Eastern Oregon Pest Management Course), resulting in a partial refund only if you contact us AT LEAST 48 HOURS PRIOR TO THE START OF THE CONFERENCE. If you do not contact us by the day before the event, NO PARTIAL REFUND will be issued.



- When applying pesticides, other than Restricted Use Pesticides (RUPs), to property owned by you or your employer
- Applications of general use pesticides by public employees with non-powered equipment, **except on school properties**
- Advising others on general use pesticides
- Applying pesticides as a part of landscape maintenance under specific conditions

How many credits do you need?

- Private Applicator: 16 credit hours at the end of the 5-year certification period
 - 4 of the 16 credit hours must be from core curriculum
 - Maximum accumulation per year is 8 hours
- Public/Commercial/Consultant: 40 credit hours by the end of the 5-year certification period
 - Maximum accumulation per year is 15 hours
- Apprentice: 8 credit hours needed each licensing period (a licensing period is from the date of license issue to December 31 of the year the license is issued).
 - 4 of the 8 credit hours must be from core curriculum
 - Credit hours will only be applied to active licenses
