Dear 4-H Individual Members:

It's time to prepare for the Eastern Oregon Livestock Show. The theme for this year's show will be "A Family Tradition". The show will kick off with our traditional clean-up day on May 31st and end with the final day of rodeo and racing on Sunday, June 8th. Encourage all your kids to participate and to bring their families. It will be a memorable event!

In addition to participating the 4-H competitions, encourage your families to join in on the following events:

EOLS Clean-up Day – Saturday, May 31st, 9:00 am. Bring shovels, rakes and wheel barrels and help get the grounds ready. Hamburgers & drinks are provided by EOLS Board. Families should bring a salad or dessert to share.

4-H/FFA Family Potluck - 6-9 pm Wednesday, June 4th at the EOLS clubhouse. Families need to bring a dessert. Meat dish, table service and drinks will be provided. For questions call Sherry Nantz, Chairman (541) 534-6515.

"Old as Dirt" Showmanship – (for adults). There will be classes for Horse, beef, sheep & swine. Animals and equipment are provided. Register at the 4-H office at the show.

We are using the on-line entry system again this year and would like all individual members to submit their entries through our 4-H website (directions are included). We have enclosed a premium book and an entry form to assist you with organizing your entries. If you need help or do not have access to a computer with internet service, please call our office for assistance. We will also accept paper copies if needed.

Important Show Information

For all exhibitors:

- U All Exhibitors must enter through their club leader (Agent if outside of Union County).
- U 4-H Exhibitors, parents and leaders are responsible for reading the premium book and knowing the rules. **There are changes.** Families can pick up a copy of the EOLS premium book at our office or download a copy from our 4-H website.
- T There will be a \$5 entry fee per exhibitor. This needs to be turned in to the Extension Office by May 15th. Checks should be made payable to Union County 4-H Leaders Association.
- T ALL Exhibitors MUST wear their exhibitor number during competition. Number will be available at the show.
- T Country Insurance is sponsoring additional premium money for **all** exhibitors in showmanship contests again this year. (Remind your kids to send thank you's!)
- T ALL Exhibitors are strongly encouraged to participate in the judging contests for their division.

For livestock exhibitors:

- U Out-of-County exhibitors are encouraged to solicit buyers for their market animals.
- U Union County Clubs will be allowed to mail a promotional letter to prospective auction buyers but MUST follow the guidelines and use the template format. Details are enclosed.
- U Change of ownership slips for steers MUST be turned in at weigh-in time
- U Registered livestock in breeding classes should turn in a copy of their registration papers to the Union County Extension 4-H office by May 15th deadline.
- U Exhibitors MAY have to provide their own bedding. Due to increased shortage of wood products and increased shipping costs we are still trying to solve this problem. We will send a notice by mid-May to agents and Union county 4-H families.
- U Hogs will have cement floor (no chips allowed). You can bring a rubber pad 3 ½' x 3 ½' if you wish.

- U Club members may bring feed to animals but no vehicles will be permitted after 8:00 am each morning.

- U Record books are required for:
 - *Union County Cattlewomen Award
 - *Jody Schubert Memorial Award
 - *Rayburn Livestock Award
 - *PGG Record Book contest
 - *Allied Beef Award*and* must be in the EOLS 4-H office by Thursday 8:00 am, June 5th.
Be sure to read specific contest rules in premium book.

- U All exhibitors are required to be present for showing their auction animal in the sale. If you have a legitimate conflict with these events you must submit a written request to the EOLS Board of Directors before their May 13th meeting to ask for a waiver (see auction rules).

All entries MUST be in our office by May 15th at 5:00 pm. We will gladly accept them earlier. Online entries can be made beginning May 1st.

SEE YOU AT CLEAN-UP ON MAY 31st. Please have families bring a salad or dessert to serve at least 8-10 people. THANKS!

Directions for EOLS Entries

Online Entries:

1. All entries must be made by:
 - * Club leader if located in Union County
 - * 4-H Agent if located outside of Union County
 - * Only individual members located in Union County will be allowed to enter their own entries.
2. For on-line entries go to the Union County 4-H website:
<http://extension.oregonstate.edu/union/>
3. Click on Eastern Oregon Livestock Show
4. Click on EOLS Entries 2008
5. Log in as your club leader (your password will be 80000)
6. First page that comes up is your directions for entering your members and their classes - **Print This Page.**
7. Note: All exhibitors from EOLS 2007 are still in the database so you can enter your members name, then password of "1". If they showed last year their name will pop up as well as their address. Please check to make sure spelling and address are correct. Make changes at this time if needed.

If they are not in the database- enter their first name, last name with a password of "1". Then enter address.
8. **Remember to complete the stalling requests at the end of your entries.**
9. When entries are completed, print a receipt for your records.
10. Mail or drop off a copy of the receipt with the Show Entry Fee (\$5 per exhibitor) to the Extension Office by May 15th. Make checks payable to **Union County 4-H Leaders Association.**

Paper Entries:

1. Fill in the form provided with exhibitor names, class numbers, and indicate stall preferences.
