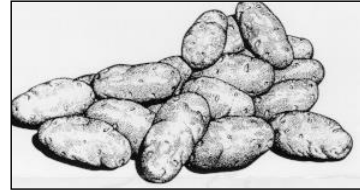


**DATE:** 6/16/15 **WEEK #:** 3
