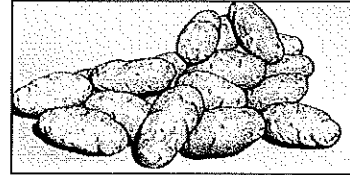

"This season the trapping program is monitoring a total of 10 sites for potato psyllid populations in Union-Baker Co. Any potato psyllid samples collected will be tested for zebra chip at the OSU-HAREC Diagnostic Lab. So far, potato psyllid appearance began the first week in July and since then the number of trap locations with potato psyllids have increased. Population levels have been low across Union-Baker Co., however, one trap location this week did show an increase in potato psyllid numbers. Through July 22, a total of 25 potato psyllid samples have been collected this season. Sixteen samples collected during week 4 (July 1), week 5 (July 8/9) and week 6 (July 15) have tested "NEGATIVE" for zebra chip. Nine samples collected this week are enroute to OSU-HAREC for testing.
