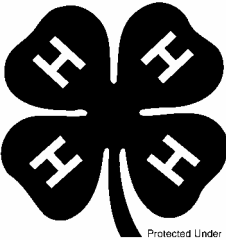

Who May Attend

You are eligible to attend camp if you are in the 4th, 5th, or 6th grade in the 2004—2005 school year. 4-H members have priority until June 3rd.

Spaces are limited at camp. Spots will be filled on a first come first served basis.

Cost

Cost for the camp is \$125, which covers meals, lodging, insurance and craft supplies. You must provide your own transportation to and from camp. You must send a deposit of \$50 with this application. The final payment of \$75 is due **Friday, June 3rd.**

Scholarships may be available from your County Extension Office. Please call for forms.

NOTE: Fees will not be refunded after June 3rd unless we can fill the vacancy.
