

CAMP RULES

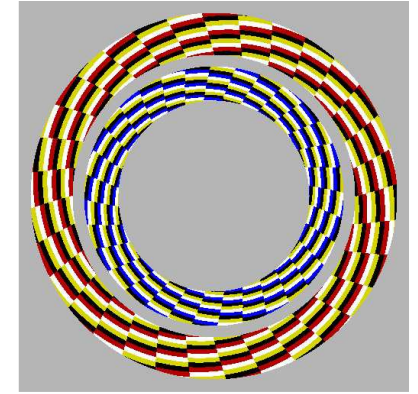

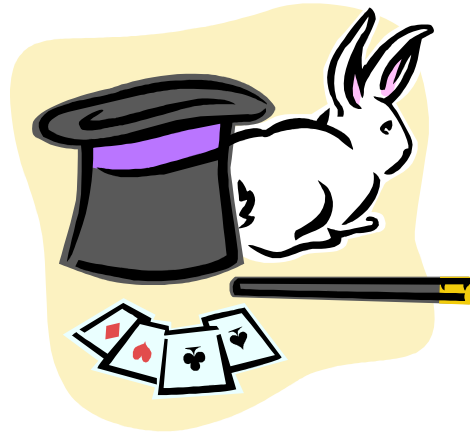
