The Washington County 4-H program has received generous donations from the Hilda Highbe Summer Conference Scholarship Fund and the Tualatin Extension Study Group. This will enable Washington County 4-H to extend Summer Conference financial need tuition assistance. These scholarships will cover up to 50% of the tuition for Summer Conference per person approved. Please review the following information regarding the scholarships to assist in your application process.

1. Youth must be a member of 4-H in Washington County.
2. Youth must be completing grades 7-12 and able to attend Summer Conference to receive the funds.
3. Funds must be used for participation in the current year's Summer Conference.
4. Participation in the Free and Reduced lunch program will be used to assess financial need.
5. Funds will be dispersed based on the committee's decision. Decisions made by the committee are final. All parties will abide by the committee's decision.
6. No funds will be given directly to a youth; all funds will be sent directly from the Extension office.
