## **Exhibit Judging: (One (1) exhibit per class)**

- HEARTH exhibits, except Horticulture Exhibits, will be judged on **Saturday, July 22, from 10:00 am – 3:00 pm. Arrive by 2:00 pm to ensure all exhibits will be judged prior to 3:00 pm.**
- Horticulture exhibits will be judged on Tuesday, July 25 from 4:00 pm – 7:00 pm in the Washington County Fair 4-H Main Exhibit Hall. Arrive by 6:15 pm to ensure all exhibits will be judged prior to 7:00 pm.
- **An important part of the 4-H learning experience is the opportunity to meet with a judge and review the project. Therefore special conditions apply for submitting exhibits without attending the judging day(s):**
  - A member may submit up to **4 (four)** total exhibits.
  - These exhibits must be brought to the judging day during the listed times, note on exhibit tag that exhibitor is not attending judging day(s)
  - Exhibits are eligible for ribbons and qualifying for State Fair.
  - Exhibits are NOT eligible for premiums and special awards.

**All 4-H HEARTH Exhibitors** are expected to complete a minimum two (2) one hour “HEARTH Duty” in the 4-H Main Exhibit Hall noon to 7:00 pm daily of the following Fair Dates – **July 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, or July 30<sup>th</sup>.** Sign-ups for “4-H Main Exhibit Hall HEARTH Duty” will be taken during HEARTH Judging Day, **July 22.**

- All exhibits are to be picked up on **Sunday, July 30 8:00pm – 9:00pm or Monday, July 31 9am – Noon.**
- Register for the classes you plan to exhibit. **Exhibit forms are due, at the OSU Extension Education Center, 1815 NW 169<sup>th</sup> Place, #1000, Beaverton, Oregon, by 5:00 pm June 1, 2017.**
- Each area requires specific tags and explanation cards. Please carefully read the fair book sections for each of your exhibit areas.
- To make sure your exhibit does not get lost; label each exhibit with your name, county, and the exhibit class. Sew the label in the inside or on the back of textile items. Securely attach a label to all other exhibits. All items must be labeled prior to judging.

## **Special Awards:**

- Exhibits awarded a Special Award will receive a Special Award Sticker on the exhibit tag.
- Members are encouraged to attend the **Fashion Revue and HEARTH Special Awards Presentation on Saturday, July 29 at 2:00 pm in 4-H/FFA Main Exhibit Hall.**

## **Premium and Special Award Redemptions:**

- Available times to redeem premium vouchers are listed on the vouchers. **No premiums will be paid after the final payment time listed on premium vouchers.**
- Redemption of HEARTH Special Awards may be picked up directly after the Special Award Presentation **on Saturday, July 29 at 2:00 pm**, after the completion of Thank You Notes, or when exhibits are picked up **Sunday, July 30, 8 pm – 9 pm, or Monday, July 31 9am – Noon.**
- Commodity/State 4-H sponsored awards are submitted after the county fair and monies are distributed by the **4-H HEARTH Advisory** as they are received. Please note that this process can take a several months.

- 4-H Exhibit Hall set-up on **Monday, July 24<sup>th</sup>** starting at 9:00 am.
- Daily during fair hours – **July 27 thru July 30**
- Exhibit Hall take down and clean up on **Monday, July 31, 9:00 am – Noon.**

**State Fair:** If your exhibit is selected for State Fair. **Review** State Fair instructions attached to the exhibit tag & complete a **new exhibit tag** and **new explanation card** if **damaged, messy, or revisions are suggest by judge.**
