Overview of the Washington County Budget

This month we will have a visit by representatives from the Washington County Administrative Office (www.co.washington.or.us/CAO/) who will present the county’s budget. We will learn the sources of revenue and how the money is distributed to the various county departments. Like any modern corporation, Washington County’s finances are complex and inter-related and this topic will focus on high-level inputs and outputs. Update on Bonny Slope West Concept Planning

The Bonny Slope Area 93 addition of 400 acres to the Urban Growth Boundary in 2002 has presented some significant challenges in planning the nature of its development.
