- 7:30 Urban and Rural Reserves** – Significant population growth is expected in the Metro area in the next 20 years. What are the opportunities and challenges to managing growth? Washington County staff will discuss the Urban and Rural Reserves designation process which intends to identify where growth can be logically and efficiently accommodated and where agriculture, natural landscape features and forests need to be protected for the next 40 - 50 years. Long term impacts on CPO-3 will mostly focus on infill and redevelopment as well as increased transportation pressures. Staff will put the Reserves process into the context of other planning processes going on: Big Look, Urbanization Forum and Metro's "Making the Greatest Place: 2040 Concept Plan".
