Long-standing Ash Creek drainage problems and concern for flooding in Tigard-Metzger area – Dr. Eugene Davis** a CPO member will provide some history of this issue and describe concerns of citizens in the area. In 1986, Washington County developed the Ash Creek Drainage Master Plan – a capital improvements program and a 20 year implementation schedule for storm drainage systems. Fees were created and put in the Surface Water Management Fund. Clean Water Services and other jurisdictions have developed more current plans which address drainage issues and projects in the area. Citizens have concerns about blocked drainage, maintenance and alignment of culverts in the half mile of the southern end of Ash Creek. The confluence of Ash Creek and Fanno Creek between Hwy 217 and the railroad track is an area of particular concern. This meeting will provide an opportunity for citizens to discuss these concerns with each other.
