- 7:20 PM** **Urban and Rural Reserves in CPO 7 – Urban and Rural Reserves in CPO 7** – Multnomah and Washington Counties are required to designate land surrounding the current urban growth boundary as urban reserve, rural reserve, or undesignated. Land that is designated rural reserve will be protected for agriculture/forestry/natural resources for 40-50 years. Both Washington County and Multnomah County are studying land in and near CPO 7 for the urban or rural reserve designations. Come participate in a discussion of what those designations might mean and invite your neighbors--particularly if they own or farm the land in and near CPO 7.
