7:15 Urbanization Forum Next Steps: Resolving Urban Unincorporated Area Service and Governance Issues – Mark Cushing, facilitator of the Washington County Urbanization Forum, will discuss the second phase of the Urbanization Forum process. 2. What are the Forum's plans for reaching out to citizens and increasing participation in upcoming local area groups?
3. How can the CPOs within the urban unincorporated areas assist in broadening outreach into their communities?
4. How will the Urbanization Forum Steering Committee and/or jurisdictions contribute to the local area discussions?
5. What progress has been made in identifying financial resources required to provide enhanced urban services in urban unincorporated areas?
6. What changes, if any, would need to be made to Urban Service Area Agreements (USAAs) and Urban Planning Area Agreements (UPAAs) to permit other urban service providers and forms of governance? Have the cities indicated they are willing to alter these agreements?
7. What is the "promise" given to citizens who participate in local area groups regarding their recommendations on urban service preferences and governance issues?
8. Have the cities discussed how they will address the concerns of citizens who may eventually live in "island" areas, created as a result of annexation of new UGB lands?
