Members bringing dogs to the County Fair are required to have their dogs currently vaccinated against Rabies, DHL, or DHLP and Parvo Virus. If a dog has a visible skin or physical problem, a certificate from a veterinarian is required indicating that the condition is neither contagious nor harmful to the dog during competition. Females in season will be shown at the end of the day and should remain in the area specified by the show chair during the day.

Crates are required for all dogs. All dogs must be "on lead" while on the Fairgrounds. Dogs must wear properly fitted collars. Only slip collars or buckle collars are allowed. See 4-H 1202, 4-H Dog Obedience, Showmanship and Contest Guide for specific rules.

Each 4-H Member may exhibit two animals per class number but cannot exceed seven animals. The same dog may not be entered in more than one obedience class.

State Fair Selection: 4-H Members must earn a blue ribbon in either showmanship or obedience to qualify for State Fair. The quota will be filled with the top blue ribbon scores in showmanship and obedience (combined total). The quota will be filled with an equal number of Intermediates and Seniors. Members will qualify to exhibit in those classes that they have won a blue ribbon in at County Fair.
