



Mushroom Cultivation



This class will serve as an introduction to a variety of mushroom growing techniques, for Shiitake, Oyster, Lion's Mane, Reishi, and Wine Cap mushrooms. We will cover:

background information; how to begin, grow, and fruit; indoor tips and techniques; outdoor tips and techniques; growth parameters and fruiting environments; and economics of mushroom farming.

Bashira Muhammed has been studying mycology for nearly six years. At Zoom Out Mycology, a three-acre fungi farm, she manages a mushroom laboratory/clean room, fruiting chamber, and a spawn room. Bashira serves as the 2020-2021 ASSOU (Associated Students of Southern Oregon University) Director of Sustainability and Civic Engagement, and she manages the Table Rock CSA (Community-Supported Agriculture), which provides fruits, mushrooms, and herbs to members.
