

2019 Lane County 4-H/FFA Fair
Swine Tagging and Weigh In

Swine physically will NOT be required at weigh-in (nor will a scale be available to weigh swine), however a tag-in process will again be utilized for the 2019 fair. The following is the procedure ALL swine exhibitors must follow to be eligible for the market show and auction at the 2019 Lane County 4-H/FFA Fair:

1. Exhibitors may tag in two head. Siblings may share a backup, i.e. two siblings can tag in three head, and share the backup, etc...
2. All Swine must be tagged by April 20, 2019. Tag paperwork (attached) MUST be turned in ON Saturday, April 20th, between 8:00 and 9:30 am at the Sheep and Goat weigh in at the Western Oregon Expo Fairgrounds, 2000 N Douglas Ave, Cottage Grove, OR
 - a. The form must be filled out COMPLETELY
 - b. The exhibitor must attach an actual printed photo (no electronic storage mediums or e-mailed photos will be accepted) of the front, rear, at least one side view, and a decipherable (superintendent discretion on acceptability) head/side view with the ear tag IN THE EAR. If the swine has ear notches, please fill out the ear notch description portion of the form.
 - c. The swine must have their ear tagged with a Lane County Youth Livestock Auction Tag, and you must provide the tag number on this form. Please place the tag in the LEFT ear (for ease of tag reading at weigh-in, and show ring entry) if possible. Exhibitors will be notified by April 27th if the provided photos are deficient and do not meet the photo/tagging requirements.
 - d. If you cannot be present on 4/20/2019 to turn in forms, a representative of yours may turn them in for you. If you are unable to attend (and no one can attend for you) you MUST contact the Swine Superintendent PRIOR TO THE WEIGH IN to make alternate arrangements.
3. To check out tagging equipment and tags:
 - a. Beginning Monday, March 11th, call the 4-H office (541-344-5043) or and reserve tags and a tagger for the day you would like to pick them up.
 - i. Taggers may be checked out for up to 3 days
 - b. Pick up tagger and tags
 - i. Multiple tags may be checked out at once. All tag numbers checked out will be recorded by the office.
 - ii. When returning tagger and unused tags, you must account for ALL tags checked out. They can be accounted for by doing one of the following:
 1. Have a completed form with tag number on it
 2. Have the pieces of any tags that were destroyed while tagging
 3. Return any unused tags
 - a. Exhibitors will be charged \$50 for any unaccounted for tags.
4. Health record should be brought to fair and turned in when weighing in at fair.
