- September 25 – Land Stewardship Planning & Soils**
 > Learn the basics of outlining your goals and planning for natural resource management, starting with soil health.
- October 2 – Water Rights & Wells**
 > Learn about water rights, well maintenance and bring well water for nitrate screening.
- October 9 – Pasture, Manure & Mud Management**
 > Learn how grass plants grow, rotational grazing, and nutrient management. Also learn how to manage mud and manure on your property.
- October 16 – Small Livestock & Weed Management**
 > Learn about what to consider when raising small livestock and about management strategies for common weeds on your land.
- October 23 – Riparian & Woodland Management**
 > Learn about the woodlands and natural areas on your property and consider options to enhance and manage for healthy trees and wildlife habitat.
